## COUNTYWIDE ELECTED OFFICIALS AND JUSTICE OF THE PEACE DECLARATION

Republican Congressional District Committees consist of members from each county within the Congressional District. The primary purpose of the District Committee is to elect a Republican US Congressman and to assist County Committees within the District.

Rules of the Republican Party of Arkansas provide that Countywide Elected Officials and Justices of the Peace may serve as members of the District Committee if they declare that they wish to serve in that capacity.

As a member of the District Committee, you will be expected to attend two meetings per year at a location within the Third Congressional District. If you cannot attend a scheduled meeting, you are expected to assign your proxy to a registered voter from your county that will attend the meeting.
